

About your GSA RWA IPAC Statement

This guide is designed to help you understand your GSA RWA Statement when using Treasury's Intergovernmental Payment and Collection System (IPAC).

Beginning July 2013, you will be receiving redesigned statements for Reimbursable Work Authorization (RWA) and Heating Operation and Transmission District (HOTD) services, provided under GSA's Public Buildings Service (PBS). The GSA redesign of RWA Statements is part of a larger effort to modernize our billing and collections. We're committed to achieving the highest standards of customer service by providing you with timely, relevant information in a clear format, so you can more effectively manage your budget and expenditures. Equally important, we're meeting the goals of the Open Government Directive issued in 2009.

Getting your statement

Your GSA RWA IPAC Statement is issued monthly or quarterly. As of July 2013 it will be available for download from GSA's Vendor and Customer Self Service (VCSS) website, located at http://vcss.gsa.gov.

We strongly encourage you to log on to VCSS on a monthly basis to view your statement. There, you can find not only your GSA RWA IPAC Statement but also a wide range of additional information and useful resources. Once you've registered, you can submit questions or report problems about items on your statement. You can also download your billing activity in comma-separated value (.csv) format.

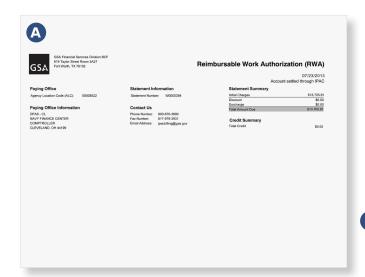

The big picture – the four sections of your IPAC statement

Your GSA RWA IPAC Statement includes charges, payments, credits and amounts due. The statement covers transactions over an entire billing cycle for a single Agency Location Code (ALC) and includes charges for all the agreements assigned to that ALC.

Information in the statement is presented in four sections: the statement overview, the agreement summary, itemized charges and the general information page.





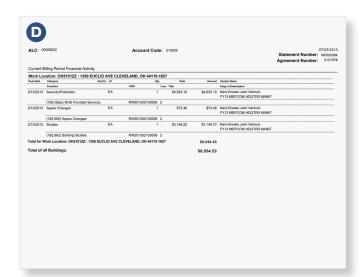
A: The first page of your statement is the statement overview. It contains key information about the statement and your agency, contact information for help if you need it and a top-level summary of your charges and credits for the billing cycle. For details on the statement overview section, see the next page of this guide.

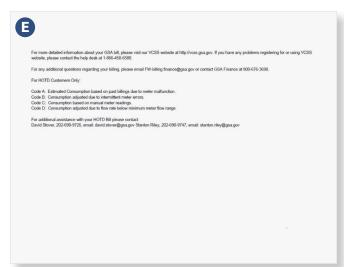
B: The second page of your statement contains the agreement summary, followed by itemized charges. If your statement covers multiple agreements, an agreement summary with its own itemized charges will appear for each agreement in the statement. See pages 4 and 5 of this guide for details on the agreement summary.

C: Itemized charges begin at the bottom of page 2, containing a description of charges and useful subtotals by work location.

D: Itemized charges may continue on additional pages of your statement. See page 6 of this guide for details on itemized charges.

E: The general information page is the last page of your statement and contains billing-related information, such as explanation of HOTD codes and contacts for help if you need it.





What's in the statement overview?

The statement overview shows charge and credit totals for the listed Agency Location Code (ALC) and therefore includes amounts for every agreement assigned to the ALC. Records are grouped by ALC and separated by agreement.

- **1. GSA Address** The address of the GSA Finance Office that handles the business line.
- 2. Agency Location Code (ALC) The code assigned to you by the Treasury Department to enable payments through the IPAC system.
- **3. Paying Office Information** The name and address associated with the Agency Location Code.

4. Statement Number

A unique alphanumeric code generated by GSA for each statement. You'll need this number if you have questions about your statement or need to initiate a chargeback.

- **5. Contact Us** GSA phone and fax numbers, and email address.
- **6. Statement Date** The date the statement was generated.
- 7. Initial Charges The total amount you incurred this billing cycle, before discounts and surcharges have been applied.
- **8. Surcharge** An additional amount charged for project management, overhead or other RWA fees.
- **9. Total Amount Due** The total sum to be collected by GSA through the IPAC system.
- **10. Total Credit** The summary of all credit transactions sent through IPAC for this statement number. Credits will appear as separate payment transactions.

What's in the agreement summary?

The agreement summary contains identifying information and charges, payments, and adjustments made since the beginning of the agreement, up to the date of the current billing cycle. Each agreement in the statement will have a separate agreement summary and begin on a new page. The identifying information will be explained here, and the agreement billing section will be explained on page 5.

13. Customer Codes Section Information that will help you reference your own agency's accounting information and understand how to apply charges.

14. Description of Work A brief description of the work to be performed, as summarized in the RWA agreement.

The second page of your statement also contains the agreement billing summary, which provides cumulative totals of charges, payments and adjustments made since the beginning of the agreement, up to the date of the current billing cycle.

15. Agreement Number

A unique identifying number for the RWA assigned by GSA.

16. Agreement Billing Summary A cumulative billing summary reflecting the charges, payments and adjustments made since the beginning of the agreement, up to the date of current billing cycle.

Previous Billed Amount: The cumulative total due as of the last billing cycle.

Chargeback/Adjustment Amount: The outstanding chargebacks not resolved.

Adjust Previous Bill Amount: The amount after chargebacks and adjustments are applied to the Previous Billed Amount.

Collected Amount: Funds that have been submitted to GSA for payment of statements.

Amount Due from Previous Bills: The uncollected amount from the last billing cycle.

Current Billing Period Amount: The amount billed for the current period.

Total Amount Due: The outstanding balance due on the agreement, calculated by adding the Amount Due from Previous Bills and the Current Billing Period Amount.

17. Cumulative Billed Financial Summary A

breakdown of all spending on goods and services provided by GSA since the beginning of the agreement, by functional category.

Total Amount: The cumulative amount expended against the agreement to date.

18. Agreement Summary A cumulative summary of RWA expenditures to date.

Authorized Amount: The total funding of the agreement.

Cumulative Billed Amount: The amount of spending to date. This total will match the Total Amount under the Cumulative Billed Financial Summary.

Agreement Balance: The amount of unexpended funding as of the current billing cycle.

What's in the itemized charges section of your statement?

In the itemized charges section of the statement, transactions for each agreement are displayed in horizontal rows. Each row includes reference information and billing details for the current billing period, by work location.

19. Work Location

Originating from the agreement, this shows where the work was performed.

- **20. Post Date** The date of the accounting transaction.
- **21. Category** The type of expenditure for the current billing period.
- 22. Adjustment Code
 (Adj cd) Adjustment codes
 appear only on HOTD bills
 and are explained on the last
 page of the statement.

- **23. Unit of Issue (UI)** Units by which goods and services are measured. The UI may vary.
- **24. Quantity** Count of each unit for the current billing period.
- 25. Rate Charge per unit.
- **26. Amount** Total charge for the transaction, based on formula Quantity multiplied by Rate.
- **27. Vendor Name** The name of the entity providing the service.

- **28. Function** The specific description of the activity.
- **29. Pegasys Document Number (PDN)** This is a unique identifier for GSA systems only.
- **30. Line** refers to the line associated with the unique assigned PDN, used only by GSA.
- **31. Accounting Line (Actg Ln) Description** If populated, this line provides more detail on the expenditure. This is used by GSA only.
